# A LASTING IMPRESSION, BOZZUTO'S BUILDING FUND

---

Together, The Hometown Foundation, Inc. and Bozzuto's, Inc. are looking to make a lasting impression to positively impact those living with a disability. The Bozzuto's, Inc. Building Fund is a fund allocated towards the building of The Hometown Foundation's 'Dream House' Project. The Building Fund was developed in the late 1970's by Adam J. Bozzuto, who had a dream to offer Special Olympics athletes and those with a disability a place where they would be able to come together, while feeling safe and included, at the 'Dream House.' The goal of the Dream House is to create a world-class facility where those with disabilities, major illnesses, Special Olympics athletes, and veterans will come together to build friendships and be a part of a supportive community. Funds are donated annually towards the building fund on behalf of private donors and dedicated Bozzuto's, Inc. employees. The anticipated goal is to raise \$10,000,000 to cover building expenses and development. The Dream House is an ongoing initiative with the hope of breaking ground in the near future.

- Assist Dog Star Rescue in the adoption of dogs at our Back the Blue Charity Ride
- Rescue and rehome 13 police K-9s that were abused at a training facility
- Support funding requests for multiple rescues with emergency veterinary needs
- Donate essential dog and cat products to animal shelters and rescues across Connecticut
- Host the annual Dream Ride Experience Pet Adoption Expo, which assisted in the adoption of more than 100 animals
- Support Animal Rescues across the Northeast through our May Pet Month fundraising program alongside our Bozzuto's, Inc. Retailers



The Hometown Foundation, Inc. proudly supports the animal welfare community. We believe pets are family and every animal is deserving of a loving home. Our Animal Welfare pillar works year-round to assist in the adoption of animals who are in search of a home. The Hometown Foundation responds promptly to disaster-stricken areas to assist in the transportation of animals and to donate supplies needed by the animal welfare community. Our goal is to continue assisting animals in disaster stricken areas, while simultaneously working with shelters and rescues to pair them with a loving home. Alongside this, The Hometown Foundation hosts an annual Pet Adoption Center at the Dream Ride Experience to assist in animal adoptions and educate individuals on the needs of the animal welfare community.

# EMERGENCY RESPONSE PERSONNEL

The Hometown Foundation, Inc. recognizes that emergency response personnel dedicate their lives and time to keeping our communities safe on a daily basis. They are always there when we need them most, which is why it is a part of our mission to give back to them. As a Foundation, we fully support emergency response personnel through monetary donations as well as supplying necessary equipment, training, attire, Police K-9s, and more. The Foundation provides educational programs and training opportunities for police and firefighters across the country through our expositions and programs. Additionally, the Foundation offers on-site training for emergency response personnel to utilize at their convenience. All units have the opportunity to train in Bozzuto's Inc. warehouses and facilities.

- Support the Make A Wish Foundation so they can continue assisting children who are battling a life-threatening illness

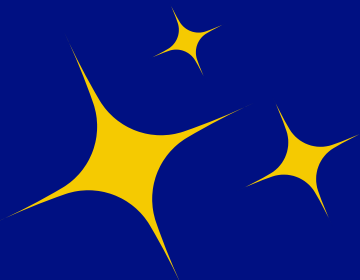

- Donate turkeys to provide meals for veteran organizations across Connecticut

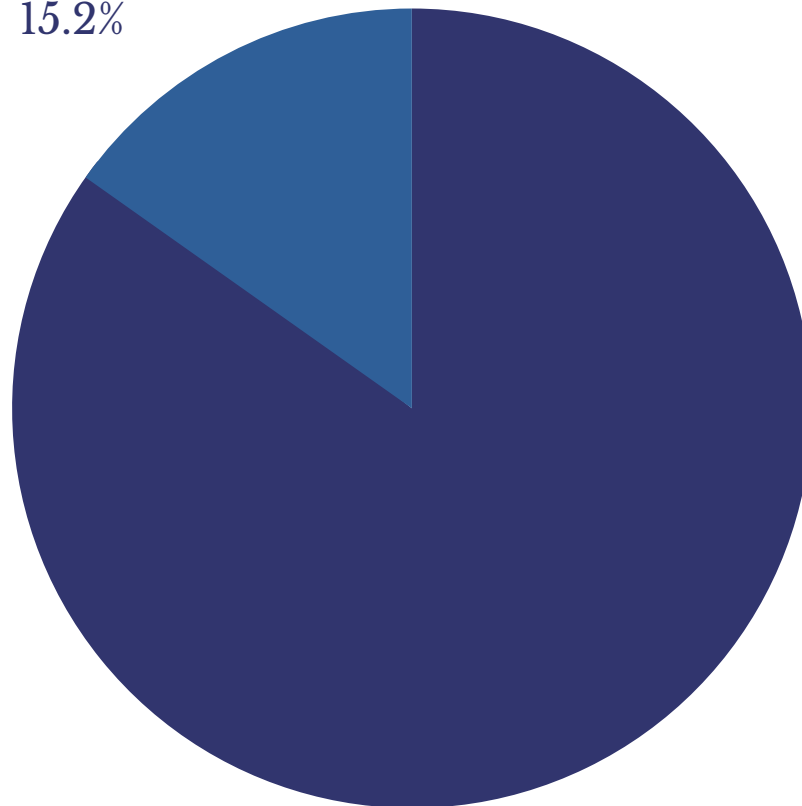

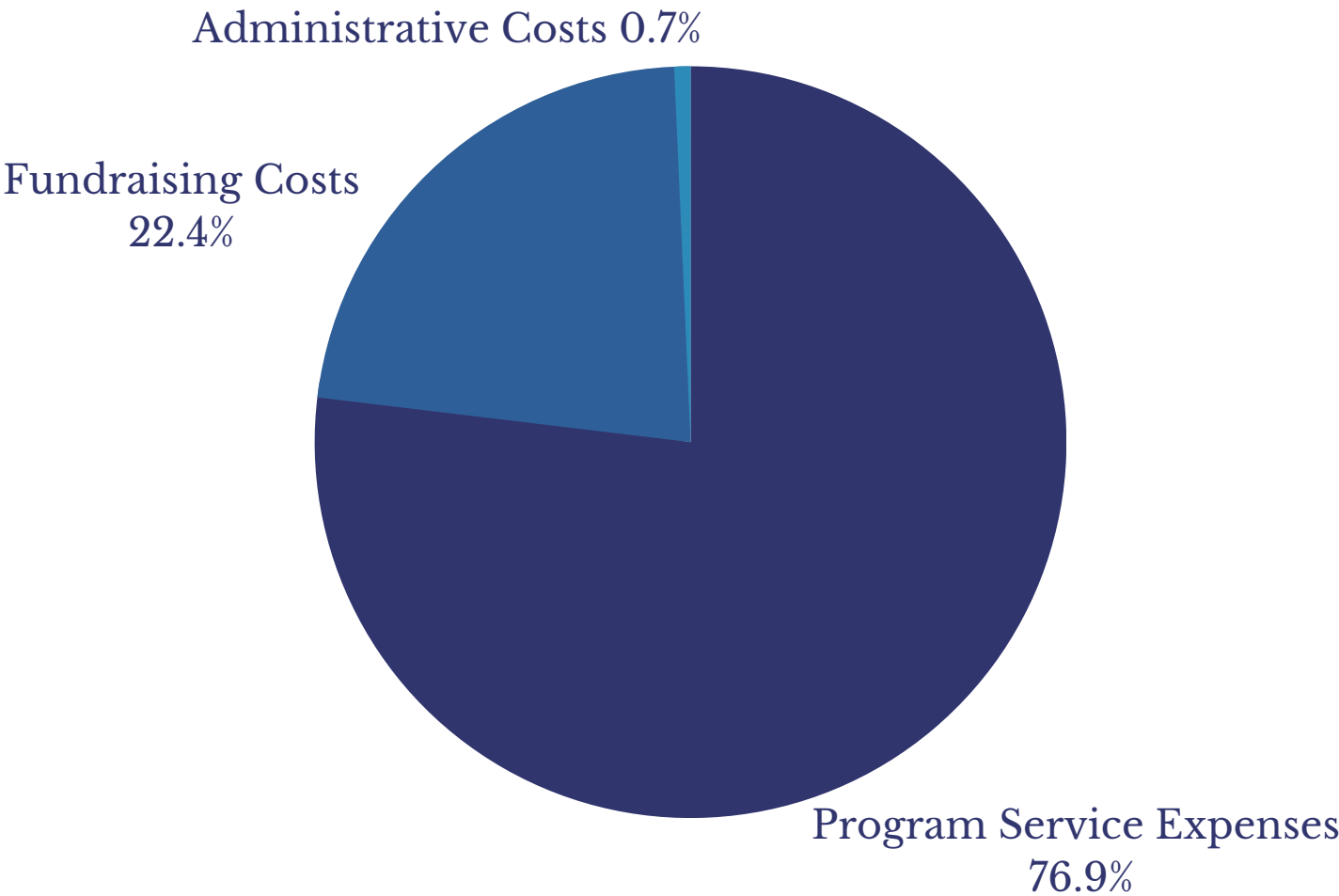

# Retailer Programs

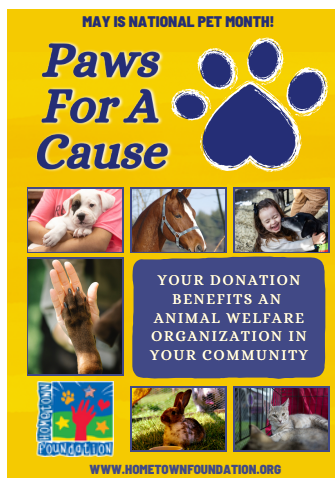
